Senior AA Provincial Champions!

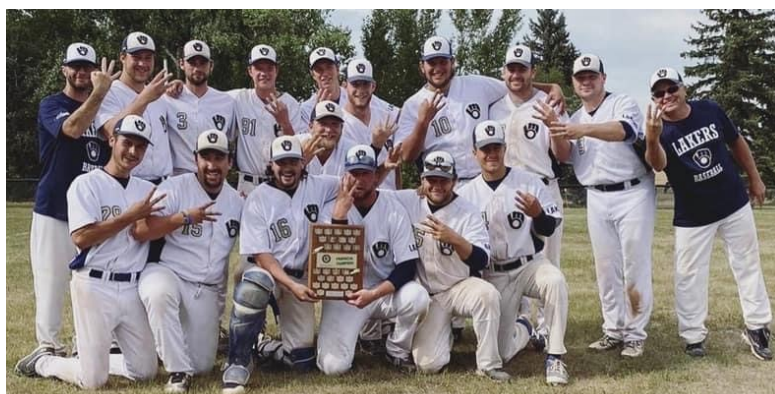
The Macklin Lakers took home their third consecutive Senior AA Provincial baseball championship August 6th-8th after knocking off the 21U Unity Cardinals and NSRBL MVP Jaydon Gartner in the final game. The Lakers came back into the NSRBL after a one-year absence due to COVID, and came out a little bit slow, but still managed to finish the season in 6th place with a 6-5 record. Manager Derrick Lantz said the players were a bit rusty due to not playing since 2019, but was happy with the team's overall play during the season. The Lakers ended up losing out in the first round of league playoffs to the Lloydminster Twins which was an entertaining best of three series going the full three games.

As for Provincials the Lakers started off their weekend with an 8-5 win vs the Saskatoon Rockies in which Jared Hillis pitched a strong game. Game two was a back-and-forth affair against the host Central Sask Cannons, which had the Lakers down 9-5 heading into their last at bat in the bottom of the 7th inning. Macklin scratched and clawed their way back into the ballgame, putting some hits together, and tying the score at nine, forcing the game into extra innings. The Lakers managed to keep the Cannons off the scoreboard in the top of the 8th inning in which Tye Scherger looked very composed on the mound striking out three of the four batters he faced. In the bottom of the 8th inning the Lakers ended up loading the bases and rookie Cody Gartner came up with a bloop infield single to win the game 10-9. Manager Derrick Lantz said that this was probably the biggest comeback in the Lakers eight year history.
