WHAT SHOULD I DO WITH THE SNOW FROM MY DRIVEWAY?

It is the policy of the Town of Macklin to clear snow from all streets as soon as possible after a large snowfall with the equipment available. When clearing the snow from your sidewalks or driveway, please make every effort possible to deposit this snow onto your own property. By blowing, shoveling or moving the snow from your driveway or sidewalk onto the street, you are compounding what already is a daunting task. We understand that there are certain circumstances where this is not possible and in these extreme cases the street is the only option. Your assistance when removing your snow will allow the Town maintenance staff to quickly and efficiently clean snow from our streets.

Please make sure you are visible and give plenty of distance to Town snow removal equipment when clearing streets.



Snowmobile Bylaw



The use of snowmobiles and all terrain vehicles are covered under legislation passed by the Province of Saskatchewan and violations of this act are enforced by the local RCMP. Persons owning and operating any snowmobile or ATV should know what is permitted under this piece of legislation. Please contact any member of the RCMP by calling 753-2171 to discuss your rights as a property owner or ATV owner.

Complaints under the All Terrain Vehicles Act should be directed to the RCMP. As responsible vehicle owners please respect the rights of private property owners and members of this community. Violations may be issued for excessive noise, intrusion onto private property of any other violation covered under the above mentioned legislation.

Town Bylaw 01/10 allows snowmobiles and ATV's to operate in Town limits Only for the purpose of exiting or entering the community. When entering or exiting the most direct route should be followed.






